



### **SGT Parry Street Naming and SGT Parry Day**

One of Jugiong's greatest heroes will be honoured this Friday when a town street is named in his honour

At 5pm this Friday, October 26, Hilltops Council Mayor, Brian Ingram and NSW Police Deputy Commissioner, Gary Worboys will unveil Jugiong's newest street, Parry Street.

Residents of Jugiong agreed to name the street after Sergeant Edmund Parry of the NSW Police who was fatally wounded in a gunfight with the infamous bushranger, Johnny Gilbert, a member of Ben Hall's Gang, at Jugiong on November 16, 1864.

During the shootout Sergeant Parry was wounded twice yet refused to submit to the bushrangers, yelling, "I will never surrender," but the 32-year-old Sergeant was fatally shot a third time through the back.

His comrade, Sub Inspector O'Neil was forced to surrender having no bullets left, but in a last show of defiance threw his empty revolver at the head of Ben Hall.

In a way to show their appreciation of Sgt Parry and his gallant efforts of laying down his life for the town Jugiong residents thought it only appropriate that a street be named in his honour.

His actions were courageous and deserving of his memory being honoured in such a way.

With such an honour occurring on Friday it will be a great lead into the 2018 Sergeant Parry Memorial Day happening in the village on November 3.

Jugiong will again come alive with gunfire and bushrangers to commemorate the sacrifice of the local policemen.

Watch as history is brought to life by members of the Gold Trails Reenactment group and the 73rd Regiment of Foot.

These groups will recreate the Lambing Flats Gold Fields and Gunfight between Sergeant Parry and the Hall Gang.

Enjoy food and drinks with activities for the kids.

The Sgt Parry Memorial day will kick off at 2pm and go through with entertainment till 8pm

So get along to Jugiong this Friday and next weekend for some great family fun and honouring a wonderful hero.
