Scoliosis Information attached (Year 5 Girls only)

Scoliosis (spinal curvature) is an important health problem for adolescent girls. 25 girls per thousand are at risk of developing a significant curve and 3 girls per thousand require active treatment (spinal brace or surgery). In the early stages the condition is most often asymptomatic so screening in the age range of 10—12 years is a sound preventative measure. Please read the enclosed information.

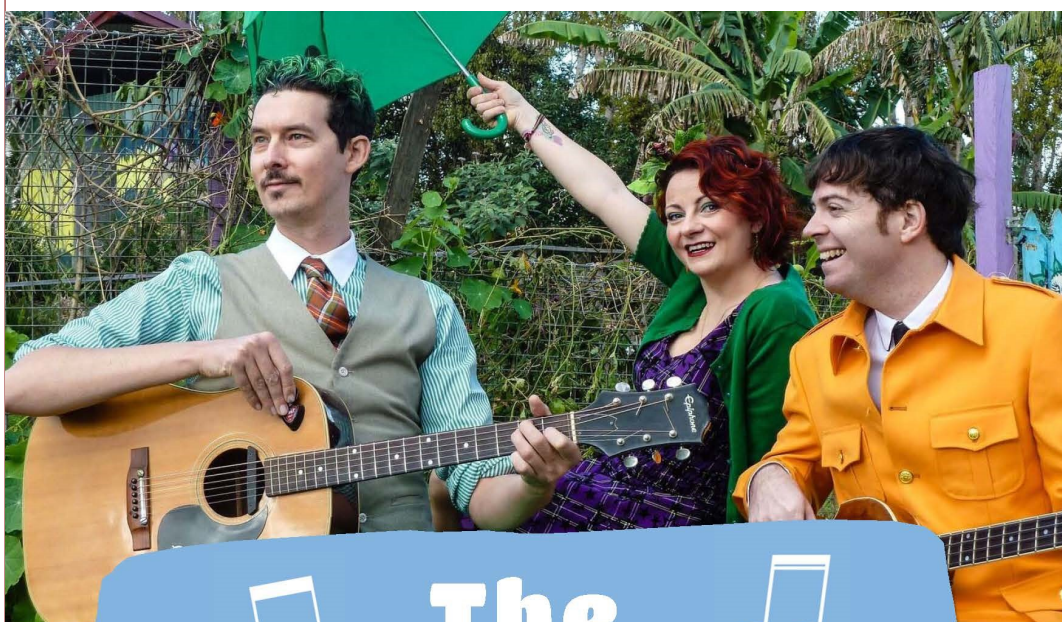

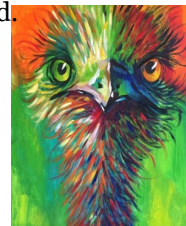
