Woolworths Earn & Learn is back—Start Collecting Today

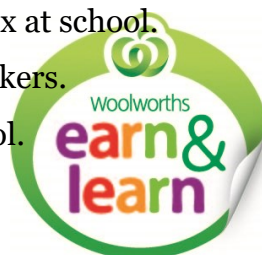
Between 1st May & 25th June, collect as many stickers as you can.
