I have loved my first few weeks at Jugiong and am getting used to the routine and school rules (especially all the technicalities of 'round the world' basketball). In class K-2 are revising the letters of the alphabet and their related sounds to enhance our reading and writing. I am introducing some fun, new maths games and we are singing lots of educational songs.

A note on homework. While it is essential that children have a break from learning each day, I hope that each student is able to spend a little time each day reading their home reader, working with their spelling list and sounds as well as consolidating their maths skills e.g: counting by 1s, 2, 5, 10 etc and recognising shapes in the environment.

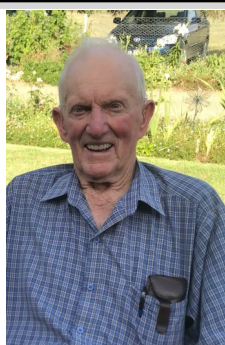
