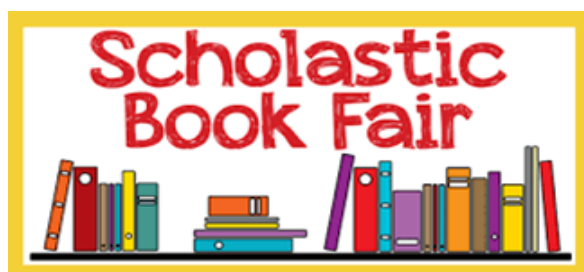
Education Week Open Classrooms

Book Parade and Fair dates: Thursday 22nd August 2019

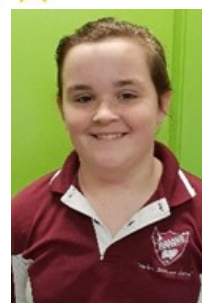
