On Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> February, our year 3-6 students joined over 20,000 other students to participate in a webinar for Safer

The webinar was convened by the office of the eSafety Commissioner in collaboration with the Department of Education's Aurora College. ## COVID Intensive Learning Support Program (ILSP)

The NSW government is committed to ensuring that every student's learning is on track after the disruptions experienced in 2020. To achieve this, NSW schools are recruiting up to 5,500 educators to deliver small-group tuition programs to students experiencing the greatest need. At Jugiong Public School we have secured funding to employ an educational paraprofessional (Danielle Manton) to provide one on one and small group support in literacy and numeracy for one day per week for this year. Parents of students involved in the program will be advised shortly. The COVID ILSP funding received by schools is only for the 2021 school year.
